

What is an Internship?

The Internship is an eleven month intensive ministry development training programme majoring on character development, set within a city church. Individuals with the call of God on their life are exposed to six vision areas within the leadership structure of EDEN and are personally mentored by the senior leadership team learning the practical aspects of serving church vision, in a local, national and international expression. Each selected Intern, will be exposed to each of the following departments:

Administration and Community
Creative Ministries
Kingdom builders
Pastoral care and support
Teaching and Training
Children and Youth
Sunday service management

Training will primarily cover three aspects-

1. Keys to Biblical Leadership and Character.
2. Practical skills - how to serve the local church vision and philosophy.
3. Impartation of leadership gifting and vision.

The Process – This is accomplished by:

1. Participation in our leadership night college.
2. Hands on participation and training, through all of the six vision departments within the church during the period of internship.
3. Mentoring by
 - A) Senior Pastors*
 - B) Vision team; and
 - C) Senior leadership

Ministry Internship

Ministry Internship is a seven month practical ministry development course.

The internship seeks to take you on a journey. Statistics tell us, 80% of all people learn from a practical hands-on approach to learning, whilst only 20% learn from a theoretical approach. Why then do we educate 80% of the world's people from a theoretical, sit down environment of learning?

The internship seeks to break new ground in the training of God's people, by reversing traditional patterns of training and placing an emphasis on the practical.

80% of the internship will be hands-on. Jesus taught his disciples whilst on the way to their destination. Our underlying philosophy is to train you in God's word, and apply it to daily life, and character building. We will do this by imparting to you spiritual gifting and vision.

Eden Internship Programme 2019-2020

The purpose of an internship is to provide a realistic exposure to the day to day operation of church leadership. Internship is a balanced approach to church service, which provides focus in three areas:

Spirit

Daily bible study through a range of leadership training days and courses, with a personal mentoring programme.

Soul

Practical discipline of working within one of our vision areas to advance the vision and direction of the church.

Body

All ministry must be balanced in order to be effective. Learning how to finish the race well, is integral to longevity.

Interns are assigned a specific area of service to invest into. The objective being to grow an effective team that advances the vision of Eden.

A ministry intern is expected to attend all Church events as a representative of the ministry team.

Each Intern is assigned to a senior leader for the duration of the course and will participate in six selected departments over this period. Those showing a specific capacity within a certain department may be granted department status throughout the Internship.

The Programme:

- Personalised mentoring from international senior ministries team
- Church planting /short term mission trips
- Ongoing leadership development programme and assessments
 - Personalised assignments and projects (Including church exchange days)
 - Community programmes to serve the city

NB: Participation in all facets of church life is essential, with the **internship being the priority**

Your day, what to expect:-

- Each office day starts at 8:30 am with corporate prayer and progress reports, ending at 4:00 pm Tues - Fri (minimum 780 hours course duration)
- Intern department meeting and the assignment of departmental duties
 - Job sheets allocated and signed off
 - Daily / weekly goal sheets evaluated
 - Inspirational teaching and impartation
- Team building with a personal development component with the senior ministry team

Applicants must show means of financial support during the Internship course.

Short term missions trips:

Each intern will be required to finance and attend one overseas conference per year with the senior pastor.
